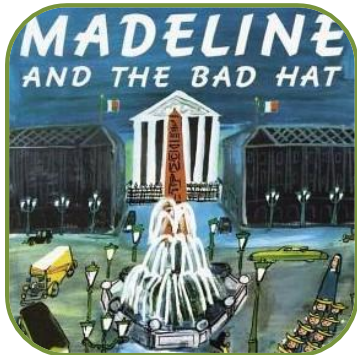
Your Alien
